

## Document 2: Privacy Policy

PRIVACY POLICY Last Updated: December 31, 2025

1. INTRODUCTION We respect your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how the AI Tutor bot ("we", "us", or "our") collects, uses, and discloses information when you use our services on Discord.

2. INFORMATION WE COLLECT Based on the technical operation of the bot, we collect and process the following data:

- User Inputs: We process the text content of messages you explicitly send to the bot via commands (e.g., the "question" in /ask or the "text" in /summarize).
- User Identifiers: We access your Discord display name to personalize the AI's responses (e.g., instructions to the AI include "As an expert tutor helping [user]...").
- Technical Logs: In the event of an error, technical details (stack traces) and the context of the error are sent to a private logging channel accessible only to the developer for debugging purposes.

3. HOW WE USE YOUR INFORMATION We use the collected information for the following purposes:

- To generate AI responses to your specific queries.
- To provide requested educational services (e.g., generating quizzes, explaining topics).
- To debug and fix technical issues with the bot.

4. DATA STORAGE The Service is primarily stateless. We do not maintain a permanent database of your conversations or personal data.

• Session Data: The bot maintains a temporary list of channels where it is "enabled" in its active memory. This data is lost if the bot restarts.

• Logging: Error logs are stored within Discord's message history in a private developer channel.

5. THIRD-PARTY DATA SHARING To provide AI functionalities, data is shared with the following third-party processor:

• Google (Gemini API): The text prompts you submit and your display name are sent to Google's servers to generate the AI response. Google's use of this data is governed by their own Privacy Policy and API Terms.

6. DATA RETENTION We do not store your conversation history on our own servers. Data processed by the Google Gemini API is subject to Google's data retention policies.

7. YOUR RIGHTS You may stop using the Service at any time. You can prevent the bot from responding in specific channels by using the /disable command. To request the removal of data potentially stored by third-party processors (Discord or Google), please contact those platforms directly.
